Currently Jason Michael walks with a walker as he does not have the ability to walk without support. It is expected that by his teenage years he will be confined to a wheelchair. The nearest specialist is located in Detroit, MI and needs to see Jason Michael on a least a yearly basis. Currently Jason Michael is attended physical therapy which, unfortunately, the medical insurance will only pay for 20 visits. As you can imagine, the family could use assistance in paying medical and therapy related costs.
